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Baba Karam – Through Jamileh and Khordadian is a participatory dance performance based on the popular Iranian dance form Baba Karam. The project by the Swedish art collective Konstgruppen Ful is inspired by queer clubs and separatist parties where everyone gets to dance for and with one another. Three performers and a DJ in drag appear on the film screen and invite you to dance and listen to memories of dance. Konstgruppen Ful invite us to a space that all of us, despite the distance, will be sharing. The physical absence of performers offers an artistic opportunity to create and explore the specific conditions confronting us in times of a pandemic and reflects the reality of people who are living in the diaspora.

The work is also a tribute to two influential and well-known American-Iranian choreographers, Jamileh and Mohammad Khordadian, who have encouraged millions of people all over the world, especially in exile, to dance. Their important work has expanded the boundaries for what dance can do and mean to people. For many, they have also been influential in framing a dance created in the diaspora.

Konstgruppen Ful is a queer feminist art collective based in Sweden that, through an intersectional understanding of art, produces performances, exhibitions, publications, and podcasts and curates talks and meetings. Ful was founded in 2008 and consists of artists and activists that are working with analysis, theory, and knowledge formation through art based on queer-feminist ideas, decolonial practices and postcolonial aesthetics. Ful has worked both in Sweden and internationally, published an award-winning art magazine entitled Ful and devised notable, internationally touring, and award-winning performances. In 2019, Ful's Nasim Aghili and Rani initiated the ongoing project *Finding Sisterhood*, a decolonising and queer mapping of contemporary dance and performance. This mapping is based on a need to mobilise and to name aesthetic movements that are vibrating and vital to contemporary dance and performance while at the same time being marginalised in its history and archives.

A letter from Swedish artists and cultural workers to our courageous colleagues in Iran, and every brave protester risking your lives fighting for justice and equality!

We see that there is a feminist revolution going on in Iran right now. The courageous cries are heard all the way here. For every injury inflicted on your bodies, we feel a wound in ours. We see you. We celebrate your struggle — a struggle that is also ours.

Following the brutal death of Jina/Mahsa Amini hundreds of thousands of people have taken to the streets in Iran. These protesters defying laws that limit everything from clothing to the rights to speak, write and create freely. We follow these historic protests that seek to put an end to 43 years of tyranny and gender oppression. We follow you as you burn your scarves and cut your hair in public spaces, even when the presence of any visible hair in the public is met with brutal or even lethal punishments.

We see that you are defying the regime's security forces. We see that you are risking everything, even your breath. We see that some of you have paid with your blood. And we say your names: Hadis, Ghazale, Behnam, Danesh, Hananeh, Reza, Farvad, Minu, Yasin and so many more with you.

It is in honor of you who — with infinite courage, take responsibility for freedom — that we write this letter. You — who, not only now but in all these years of oppression, have continued to express yourself despite restrictions. You — who fought for freedom of expression and justice. We are artists and cultural workers (many of us with our roots in the same streets you're now taking back) who want to cry out that you have our support. We support you. In your struggle lies our struggle and our infinite gratitude. We spread your words, cherish your cries. We use them as our fuel when we demand that our governments act.

No one is free, until everyone is free. Thank you!


